Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) are generally recognized as the most widely applicable and useful type of objective test items. They could be used to measure the most important educational outcomes - knowledge, understanding, judgment and problem solving. The objective of this paper is to give guidelines for the construction of MCQs.

A multiple-choice question (MCQ) is composed of two parts: a stem that identifies the question or problem, and a set of alternatives or possible answers that contain a key that is the best answer to the question, and a number of distractors that are plausible but incorrect answers to the question. Students respond to MCQs by indicating the alternative that they believe best answers or completes the stem. There are many advantages to using MCQs for assessment. One key advantage is that the questions are easy to mark, which makes them an attractive assessment approach for large classes. Well-designed MCQs allow testing for a wide breadth of content and objectives and provide an objective measurement of student ability.



Introduction, Policy and Methods of Examination Reforms Formulation

As per the statutes and ordinances, the college has established Examination Committee. Consisting of two faculty in- charge Professors, one clerk, one member from admin staff, one Professor as college examination professor (CEO), and Vice-Principal and Principal as Chairman of the committee. Department of Examination coordinates the internal and external examination at both college and university level. It shares necessary information with students, teachers and administrative staff for smooth functioning. Evaluation methods and examination schedules are displayed on the college notice boards as well as on the college and university websites. Internal assessment is done through various assessment methods. It comprises class tests, multiple-choice tests, oral examinations, assignments, projects, term-end exams, midterm and university examinations. The exam system ensures that the student's performance is mirrored in cumulative way. Marks /credits are allow assignments, seminars, orals and practical. The internal exam schedule is prepared and forwarded to students before eight days of the commencement of the said examination. Question papers prepared as per the University guidelines and submitted to exam department. For transparency, the Dept. of exam appoints junior and senior supervisors. Keeping in view the university guideline, a vigilance committee at college level is formed comprising female teachers. To notify changes in Exam schedules, patterns and methods, the Dept. of Exam has created what Sapp group that consistently keeps briefing. The subject teacher also informs the students about such changes in the class room and by counselling students.







One key advantage is that the questions are easy to mark, which makes them an attractive assessment approach for large classes. Well-designed MCQs allow testing for a wide breadth of content and objectives and provide an objective measurement of student ability.

Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) are generally recognized as the most widely applicable and useful type of objective test items. They could be used to measure the most important educational outcomes - knowledge, understanding, judgment and problem solving. The objective of this paper is to give guidelines for the construction of MCQs.

A multiple-choice question (MCQ) is composed of two parts: a stem that identifies the question or problem, and a set of alternatives or possible answers that contain a key that is the best answer to the question, and a number of distractors that are plausible but incorrect answers to the question. Students respond to MCQs by indicating the alternative that they believe best answers or completes the stem. There are many advantages to using MCQs for assessment. One key advantage is that the questions are easy to mark, which makes them an attractive assessment approach for large classes. Well-designed MCQs allow testing for a wide breadth of content and objectives and provide an objective measurement of student ability.



Google form

Google form supports powerful polls for groups and channels which can be used for everything from deciding where to have lunch to organizing public service exams.

Procedure:-

- · Open Google form
- Tap on the paperclip icon
- One of the options at the bottom will be the poll option.
- When the poll options appear, tap on the Poll option or slide the options towards the top of the screen to see them all.
- In the Poll Question section, you'll need to type your question. In Answer
 Options, by tapping on Add an option to type out an answer to your
 question. If you want to add another answer to the poll question, keep
 tapping on Add an Option.
- At the bottom, in the Settings section, you can make the voting anonymous, add multiple answers, or enable quiz mode. If you turn on Google form quiz mode, you'll be asked to choose a correct answer. Once you're done adding the question and answer for your poll, don't forget to tap on the Create option at the top. As soon as you tap on the create option, your newly created Google form poll will be published in the group. Now it's up to all the group members to answer the question. When you answer, Google form will celebrate by throwing some confetti, but if no one has answered yet, you'll see a message saying that at the bottom left of the poll.




