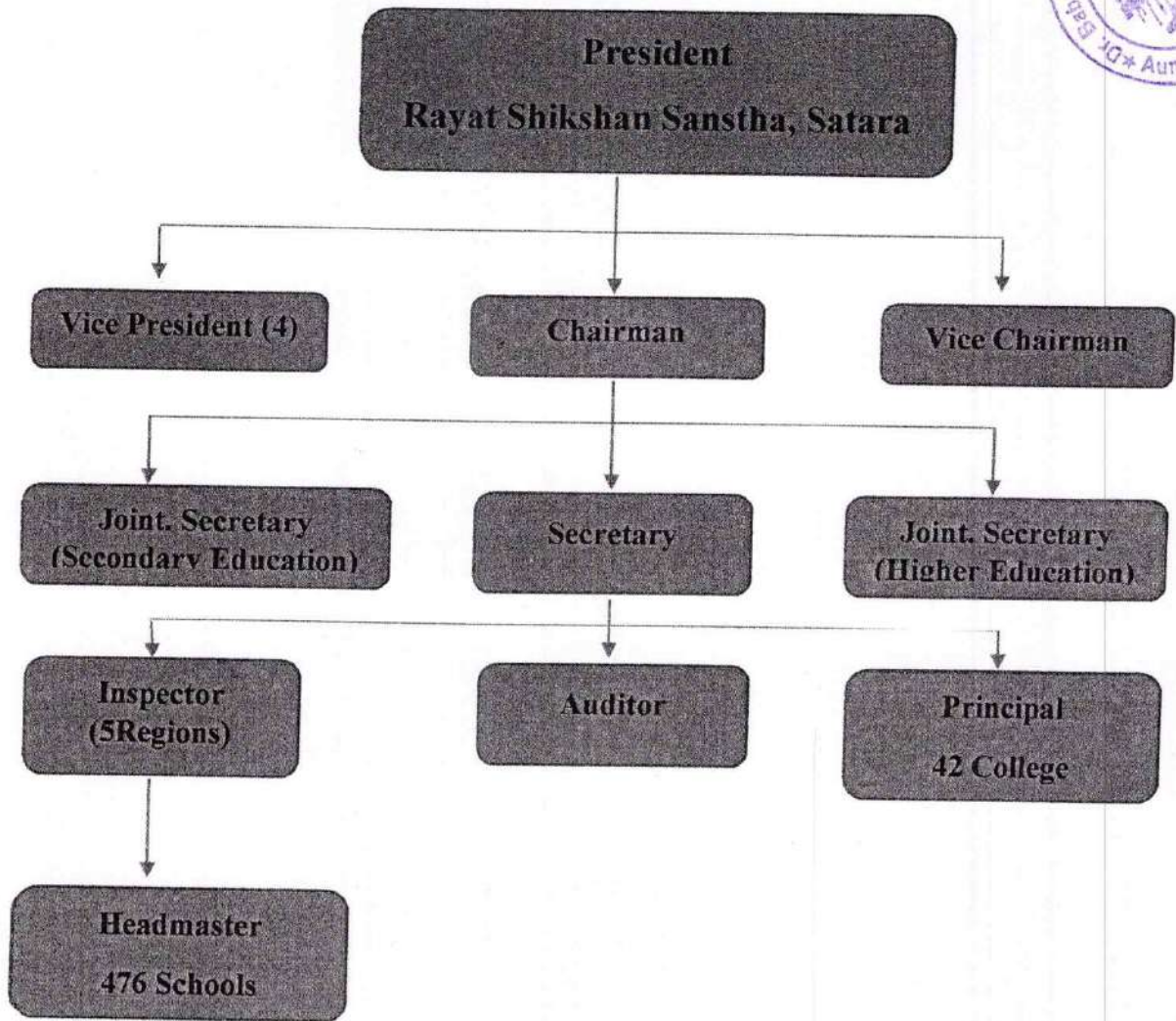
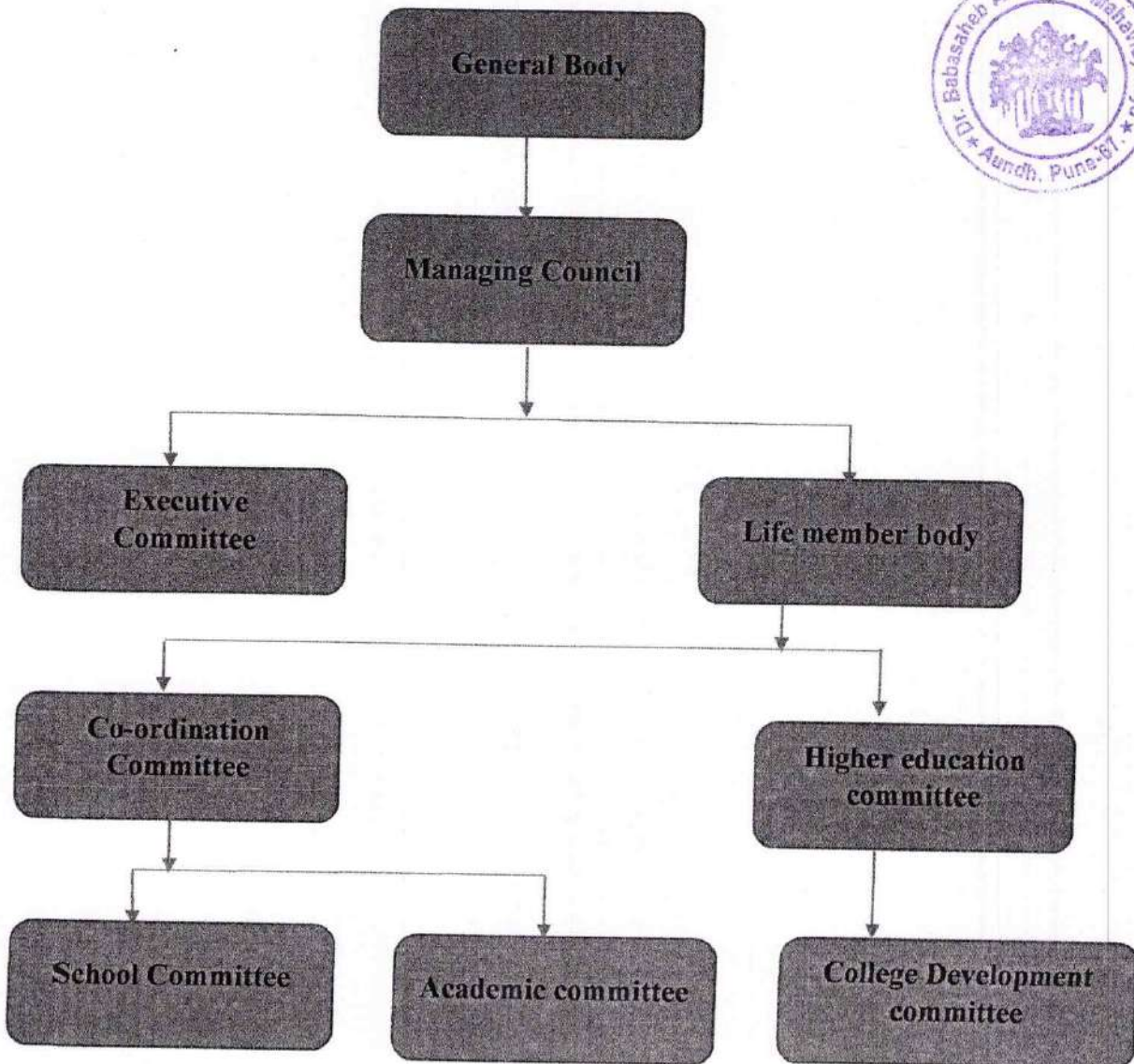


Organizational structure of the Parent Institution is as follows:

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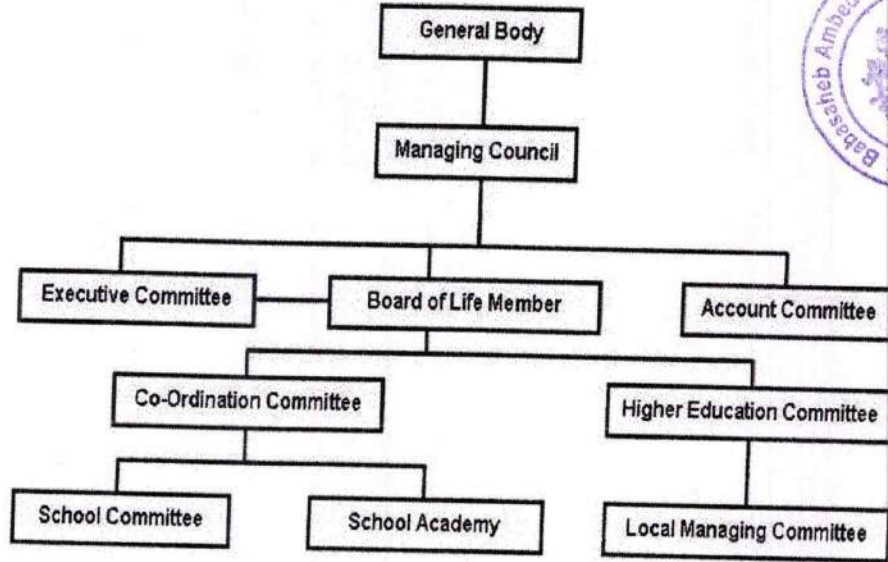

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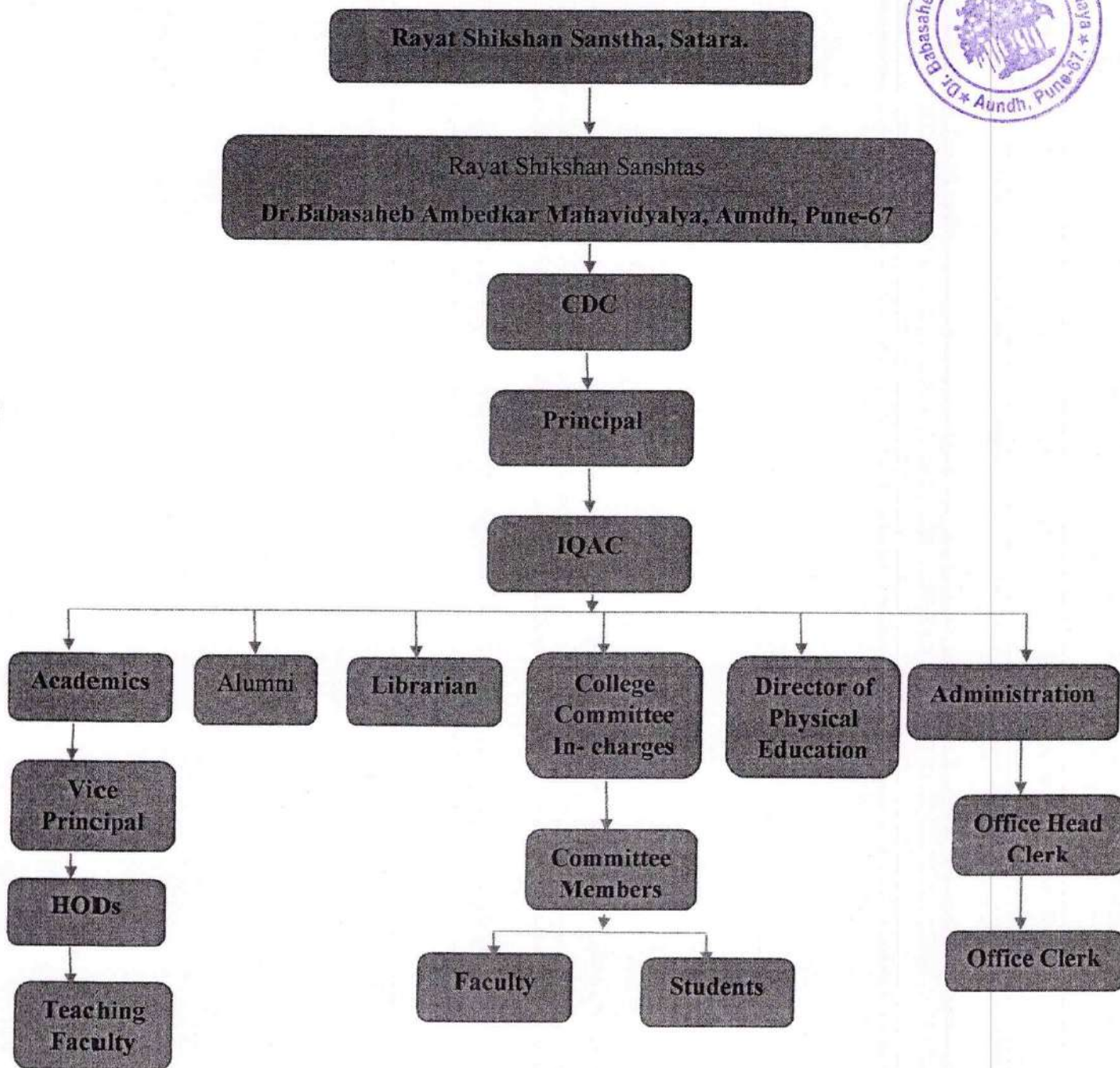

1. ADMISSION PROCESS

All admissions are made as per rules and regulations given by Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU)

Eligibility of the student to seek the admission

1. All the students (New and previous) who seek the admission in the college take their admission through printed application and fill online form on dbacap.rayatertp.in
2. All the students noted that payment of fees paid by them does not confirm admission to the college. Fees are treated as deposits and will be refunded (as per rules of Savitribai Phule Pune University Circular) if admission is not granted
3. The admission is valid only if student pays prescribed fees at the time of admission
4. The students who wish to avail themselves of government concession for fees under Economical Backward Class (EBC) Scheme should fill up prescribed application form within one week which is available in office
5. A student applying for first year under graduate classes after passing HSC examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or other board in country will have to apply through the college to Registrar, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune for eligibility certificate with original and attested copies of mark list and original school leaving Certificate
6. The student passed ICSE or CBSE or equivalent examination of coming from other state should submit below documents
 - a. Migration Certificate
 - b. Transference Certificate
 - c. Statement of Marks
 - d. Passing Certificate
7. A student admitting from any college affiliated to the Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune want to apply for second or third year- B. A./B. Com./BBA(CA)/M.A. Marathi/M.A. Economics/ M. Com. Banking and Marketing class can be directly admitted to this college if the seats are available. He/She should submit transfer certificate after joining college.
8. Regarding the of foreign student for any class they should fulfill the rules of Savitribai Phule Pune University and after getting final approval for the foreign student through the university then only they are able to take admission in college.
9. It will be the responsibility of the students to check transference and eligibility certificates received by college before the end of first term. Students from other college will be admitted



to this college only if they have good academic record. Applicants are not admitted to this college

10. Students seeking admission to this college shall bring two identity card sized photograph at the time of payment of fees

4. REFUND OF DEVELOPMENT FEES AND OTHER FEES

The candidate cancelling their confirmed admission will be entitled to receive their fund fees after deducting the amounts as indicated below except otherwise prescribed by the rules by Savitribai Phule Pune University.

1. From 1 to 10 day from the date of securing admission amount to be deducted 20% of the total fees.
2. From the 11 to 30 days from the date of securing admission amount to be deducted 40% of the total fees.
3. After 30 days amount will be deducted 100%

General Conditions

1. The other fees if any is prescribed by the state government for aided and unaided professional and non-professional courses from time to time will supersede the fees prescribed for such courses in the ordinance(s).
2. A demand draft of Registration fee, Development fee, Computer fee, Student Welfare Fund and any other fees in which university has a share shall be remitted to the university by college on or before 31st October or within one month from last date of admission whichever is later.
3. Development fees are to be charged only in case UG and PG students. Development fee is not to be charged to any certificate course(s).
4. University examination fee, library fee etc. for UG and PG courses that may be institute by the university under the respective facilities will be the same as it is prescribed by savitribai Phule Pune University unless otherwise specified by the university State Government.
5. Whenever library, development and other fees are prescribed by the State Government, the college shall charge only those fees and not fees prescribed by the University except fees which are to share with the universities
6. The vice-chancellor shall be the competent authority to interpret these ordinance rules concerning all types of fees and charge. In case there is any dispute regarding interpretation of these rules regarding of an amount of fees to be paid, the vice chancellor shall interpret the provisions of these rules and his/her decision be final
7. In case of any difficulty regarding the provision of ordinance/rules concerning fees and charges, the vice-chancellor may be order. Issue necessary directions o inconsistent with the objects and purpose of these rules which appear to be necessary or expedient for the purpose of removing the difficulty.

Short Term Course Policy

1. Preamble

Learning is the key to knowledge and continuous learning is the constant objective of our institution. Working towards this objective, our college periodically conducts trainings, lectures and various other programmes for the intellectual wellness of the students. Emerging trends in technical and professional education call for value addition i.e. students must acquire something more than what is provided in the curriculum. Hence our institution is keen on helping the students take up certificate courses to complement their knowledge and skills related to their field of study. We offer a wide variety of short term certificate courses which are conducted after class hours or during semester breaks. These courses are conducted by professionals and industry experts and help students stand apart from the rest in the job market by adding further value to their resume. Besides that, there is need to enhance their communication skills, to develop professional ethics



in them and help them learn and develop human values and concern for humanity.

2. Objective of the practice:

- To bridge the knowledge gap between academia and industry and to strengthen the regular academic programmes prescribed by the university.
- To make students familiar with all the modern and updated concepts of the industry and enhance their chances of acquiring lucrative careers.
- To help the students develop ability to solve real-time problems in industry and society.
- To bridge the skill gaps and make students industry ready.
 - To provide an opportunity to students to develop inter-disciplinary skills.
 - To expose students to recent trends in the core field and enhance their employability skills.

3. The Context:

As university curriculum does not cover all areas, it is important for higher educational institutions to supplement the curriculum to make students better prepared to meet industry demands as well as develop their own interests and aptitudes. The curricular gaps are identified through overall POs attainment, feedback/suggestions obtained from industry advisory committee and academic advisory committee. . They are bridged by conducting various programmes like value added courses, seminars, conferences, workshops and guest lectures etc. Feedback from the alumni who have got placed in top-notch companies also has also been collected which helped in introducing Self framed Short Term Courses based on the existing needs of the industry. Most of our students undergo Value Added Courses to earn credits over and above the total credit requirement



prescribed in the curriculum for the award of the degree. The Short Term Courses cultivate an urge amongst the students and position them to turn into flamboyant professionals on the latest trends and manifest their technical skills in advanced manner. These courses offer our students an edge over the others. They have their own uniqueness in the context of higher education. Altogether, there have been 27 Short Term Courses in these five years, out of which are self-framed courses and One-credit courses approved by University. Courses offered are chosen based on current trends, relevance and value in the job market. The curriculum for the one credit courses is designed by the members of faculty of our institution, and approved by University. Apart from our faculty members, industry experts are invited as resource persons for Self-framed courses. Assessment is done by conducting tests after completion of the course for one credit courses by our own institution whereas assessment for Self-framed courses is done through tests conducted by the industry. The Short Term Courses are conducted for 30 to 60 hours in a semester. They play an important role in the development of the students overall personality, thereby enhancing their career prospects.

4. The practice:

The college takes steps to find out the current needs in the industry and signs MoUs to teach such Short Term Courses. The department prepares the course contents, its delivery plan, time-table, reference books etc. for the courses. The teachers handling these courses are certified trainers who undertook training from the corresponding industry personnel and got certificates to offer training. In addition to the credits earned, after successful completion of the course, the students are issued certificates. The necessary but missing contents in any course are taught to the students with the help of these value added courses.

Code of conduct

Responsibilities of Chairman ,Co-Coordinator and faculty related to short term courses conducted by college.

- 1) Chairman :He has to make policy decision in consultation with the principal . Teaching practicals,projects,field visits, notices from time to time, keeping relations with coordinators and difficulties raised from time to time.
 1. At the end of academic year , The chairman has to decide in the meeting of coordinator the courses to be stated in the next academic year. The *planning* about it is to be made and the same is be sent to the CDC through IQAC.The details are to be sent to Karmaveer Academy ,Satara for approval.
 2. The chairman has to get the brochures and the admission forms of each course printed well within the time. He has to implement the process of admission properly. The admission forms are to be filled up in duplicate , one copy for the office and the other with the coordinator.
 3. The chairman has to consult the coordinator and discuss about the external faculty. He has to take course wise meetings with the principal and confirm the matters related to the remuneration , CDC approval to it.
 4. He has to organize workshops in each semester for one or a couple of short term courses simultaneously. He has to see that the teaching and the practical are going on as per the time table and see that everything is implemented qualitatively.
 5. The chairman has to prepare time table , MOUs if necessary in the first week of August. He has to make the coordinators aware in this regard.
 6. The chairman has to pay the remuneration per month and prepare the documentation like vouchers , reports ,duly signed by the coordinator . The same should sent to the office.



7. The chairman has to monitor regularly the teaching of all short term courses ,practical, MOUs , field visits, bank visits and projects.
8. The chairman should call the meeting of coordinators and see that The examinations are conducted as per time table.
9. The chairman , right from the beginning of the academic year should keep in mind the exhibition and trade fair . Then and then the trade fair will be successful.

2) Responsibility of the chief coordinator

The chief coordinator should consult to principal from time to time and solve the difficulties arose.

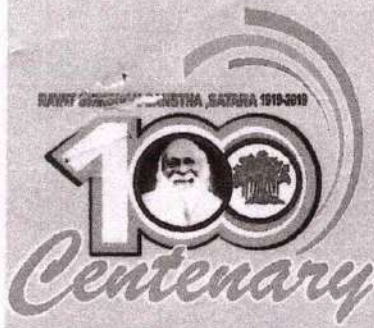
1. The chief coordinator has to see that the lectures of all courses take place as per the time table. If not, he has to make the necessary suggestions to the concerned coordinator and the same is to be reported to the principal.
2. The chief coordinator has to find out the expert faculty from outside and he has to make guidance to the coordination in this regard.
3. The chief coordinator has to call the meeting of all coordinators once in every month. The principal should be invited for the same and the discussion about difficulties came across so far should be discuss and proper solution should be found.

3) Responsibilities of Course coordinator and his assistant

The course coordinator and his assistant should see that their short term course is run effectively and the students are satisfied with it.

1. They have to prepare the syllabus of their respective course at three levels: a)Certificate b) Diploma c) Advanced diploma
2. They have to discuss with the principals about external expert teacher, their remuneration and complete the financial documents.
3. They have to see that the students attend the lectures regularly. If any difficulties are faced by the students, they have to solve it.
4. They have to prepare the attendance register of the faculty and students.
5. If the external faculty does not visit, the coordinator has to engaged the students and show them selective videos related to short term course.
6. They have to complete all activities well within the time along with the projects.
