NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

INTRODUCTION:

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a Central Sector Scheme of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. It provides opportunity to the student youth of Jr.college, Graduate & Post Graduate at colleges and University level in India. It is an opportunity to take part in various government led community service activities & programmes. The sole aim of the NSS is to provide hands on experience to young students in delivering community service. National Service Scheme (NSS) was introduced in 1969 with the primary objective of developing the personality and character of the student youth through voluntary community service. 'Education through Service' is the purpose of the NSS. The ideological orientation of the NSS is inspired by the ideals of Mahatma Gandhi. The motto of NSS is "NOT ME, BUT YOU". An NSS volunteer places the 'community' before 'self'.

Since inception of the NSS in the year 1969, the number of students strength increased from 40,000 to over 3.8 million up to the end of March 2018 students in various universities, colleges and Institutions.

OBJECTIVE:

The overall objective of NSS is Personality Development through community service. Campus to Community Linkage.

The broad objectives of NSS are to:

- Understand the community in which they work.
- Understand themselves in relation to their community.
- Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in the problem solving process.
- To develop creative and constructive social work action.
- To promote or to serve in the weaker section of community.
- Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.
- Utilize their knowledge in finding a practical solution to individual and community problems.
- Develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities.
- Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitude.
- Develop the capacity to meet emergencies and natural disaster.
- Practice national integration and social harmony.

NSS BADGE:



All the youth volunteers who opt to serve the nation through the NSS led community service wear the NSS badge with pride and a sense of responsibility towards helping needy. The Konark wheel in the NSS badge having 8 bars signifies the 24 hours of the day, reminding the wearer to be ready for the service of the nation round the clock i.e. for 24 hours. The Red colour in the badge signifies energy and spirit displayed by the NSS volunteers. The Blue colour signifies the cosmos of which the NSS is a tiny part, ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind.

MOTTO

The motto of National Service Scheme is **'NOT ME BUT YOU'**

SELECTION OF VOLUNTEER AND ENROLLEMENT FEE:

Selection of volunteer made according to guideline of Youth and Sports ministry Government of India, Government of Maharashtra and Savatribai Phule University Pune. College admitted student should apply freshly apply each year to college unit. Savatribai Phule University Pune charge Rs 20/- enrollment fee every year to the volunteer. Those who work satisfactorily get benefited as volunteer.

BENEFITS OF BEING A NSS VOLUNTEER:

NSS volunteer who takes part in the community service programme would either be a college level or a senior secondary level student. Being an active member, these student volunteers would have the exposure and experience to be the following:

- ✓ An accomplished social leader.
- ✓ An efficient administrator.
- ✓ A person who understands human nature.

ROLES / RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Students should enroll their name as an NSS volunteer in the college and enrollment is limited to 150 members in every academic year.
- Requires active participation in all the activities and to work with/among people.

- Proper dress coding with NSS badges during off the campus or on the campus is mandatory.
- Identify needs, problems and resources of the community along with program officer or local leaders.
- To establish rapport with the people in the project area for community developments.
- Every volunteer should complete 120 hours of work and keep day-to-day record in work activities/experience in work dairy and submit to the group leader/program officer for periodic guidance.
- All volunteers should work under the guidance of a group leader nominated by the program officer.
- They shall make themselves worthy of the confidence and cooperation of the group/community leadership.
- They should avoid entering into any controversial issues.

NSS COMMITTEE:

To ensure that the above objectives are attained and to promote the participation of volunteers in NSS related activities, NSS committee has been set up by the college Principal of college.

WORKING OF THE NSS DEPARTMENT / COMMITTEE:

Any NSS events will be planned in association with other committees. The committee is therefore entrusted with the planning and scheduling of community activities for the academic year. The Coordinator of the committee shall conduct informal meetings at regular intervals to discuss and allocate tasks. The committee needs to prepare the annual budget/individual event budget, keeping in mind the various events to be held over the course of the academic year. The committee would have to submit the bills and invoices for all expenditures involved to the accounts section. The committee is responsible for communicating the report for uploading on college website or arranging for press release.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT/ COMMITTEE:

The Department and the Committee will be responsible for rolling out activities.

- Some of the activities are Orientation & Registration program to the first-year Second Year students admitted in the college.
- Organizing NSS activities.
- Organizing UGC recommended activities as per Minister of Education NSS calendar.
- Awareness program about general fitness, nutrition, health and of citizenship.

- Organizing awareness program for save water, environment and cleanliness drive.

THE PROCEDURE TO ORGANIZE NSS ACTIVITIES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- Regular Activities
- Special Camping Programme

REGULAR ACTIVITIES

Under this, students undertake various need-based programmes in the adopted villages, College Campuses and Urban slums during weekends or after college hours. 120 hours per year and 240 hours for 2 consecutive years.

2.	Career guidance for the NSS volunteers, by the experts and campus work	30 hrs
3.	Skill development (first aid, disaster management, public speaking, leadership motivation, HIV/AIDS awareness etc.)	26 hrs
4.	Community Development Projects (in the adopted village)-Survey in the village, tree plantation, Health, Cleanliness, Road Safety, visits homes, technical training for rural youth and SHG, sanitation, women development programmes, consumer awareness etc.	26 hrs

SPECIAL CAMPING PROGRAMME:

Under this, 7 days residential camp organized in the adopted villages will a specified theme being given by Govt. of India by involving local youth. The Special camp should be conducted only in the adopted village (for second year NSS volunteers) at least for three years continuously.

SPECIAL CAMPING:

According to university guideline and District level, University level state level and National level camp can be attend a volunteer.

COLLEGE AWARDS FOR NSS:

- Best NSS Volunteer award trophy + Certificate for Boys.
- Best NSS Volunteer award trophy + Certificate for Girls.
- Best NSS camp group award- Certificate.


AWARD FOR PERFORMANCE

Volunteers participating in NSS as members of the College can get 1 credits per year for 120 hours of practice/ training as recorded. For every additional Camp of training/ Participation, these Students shall get additional credit.

Beside college award NSS Volunteer can apply for University/ State/ National Award through college.

DETAILS OF THE SUPPORT OFFERED BY THE INSTITUTION TO PROMOTE NSS ACTIVITIES:

- All the volunteers registered for NSS are given suitable NSS transportation & Boarding facilities.
- Volunteers taking part in any community service during the class hour will be given attendance benefit with prior permission.
- Accidentally if any student gets injured while doing the service for the society, the University provides insurance claim facility between 5 to 15 thousand.
